Writing: Communicate effectively in writing using past, present and future tenses as well as more complex structures and vocabulary. Express and justify opinions and ideas.



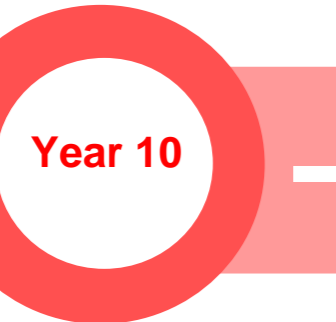
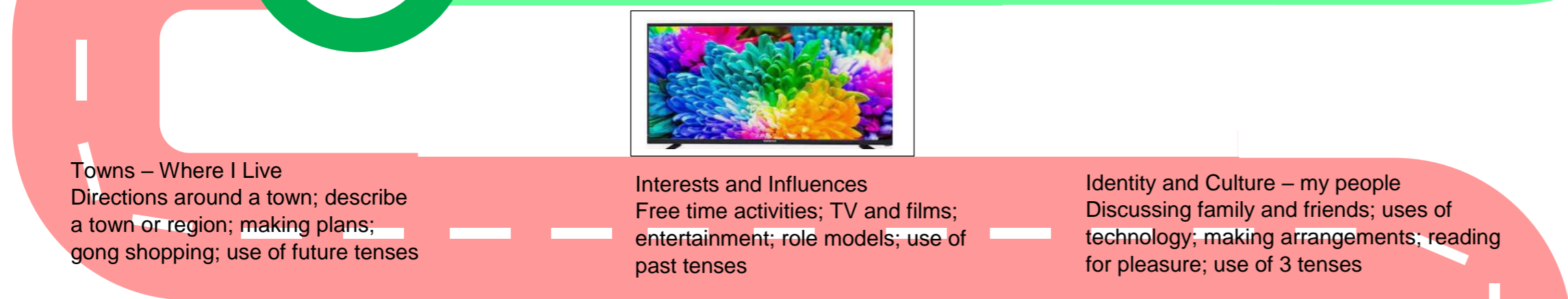
Revision and Examinations
